

PRIVACY NOTICE

Short-Form Summary — Broadside Technologies

This notice gives you the key facts about how Broadside Technologies (“Broadside”, “we”, “us”) handles your personal information when you use our website, in plain language. It is a summary only — our full Privacy Policy has the complete details and takes precedence if there's any difference between the two.

Who we are

Broadside Technologies is a South African company. We're responsible for the personal information collected through our website and are accountable for protecting it under the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA).

What we collect

- Your name, surname, company, and email address — if you submit an entry to our Broadside Defender game leaderboard.
- Your name, email address, phone number, and message — if you fill in our contact form.
- Basic technical information (like your IP address) via strictly necessary cookies and local storage when you visit our site — we don't currently use analytics or tracking cookies.

Why we collect it

- To respond to your enquiry and communicate with you.
- To understand how people use our website and improve it.
- To meet our legal obligations.

Who we share it with

We don't sell your information. We only share it with trusted service providers who help us run our website (for example, hosting providers), and only where the law requires it.

How long we keep it

We keep your information only for as long as we need it for the reasons above, then delete or anonymise it.

Your rights

You can ask us what information we hold about you, ask us to correct or delete it, or object to how we use it. If you're unhappy with how we've handled your information, you can also complain to South Africa's Information Regulator.
